



## LASER INFORMED CONSENT

## The Procedure & You

The modern technology of the Award Winning Candela GentleLASE Plus Alexandrite laser allows us to dramatically reduce excessive dark hair from anywhere on the face and body quickly. When the laser emits light, it is absorbed by the melanin along the hair follicle and the hair shaft. The laser pulses just long enough to destroy the pigment, that's less than a second, disabling multiple hair follicles in a single application. This leads to either the elimination of that hair or significant obstruction of the hair's growth. Because the laser is only emitted for a fraction of a second, it is able to affect the melanin before damaging the surrounding skin, which is protected by Candela's patented cooling technology.

## Before Your Treatment

- Avoid the sun, tanning booths, tanning lotion and spray tans for 6 weeks before treatment, longer
  if necessary to be completely tan free. If you are going to be treating sun-exposed areas, apply
  sunblock (at least SPF 50) each morning for one month before treatment.
- Refrain from bleaching, plucking, threading, electrolysis or waxing of hairs in desired treatment area for six weeks when at all possible. You may cut, shave or trim the hair.
- If you have a history of herpes or cold sores, you may need antiviral medication. This medication should be started one day before laser treatment and continued for one week after treatment.
- Carefully shave the treatment area at a time before your appointment.
- Arrive with the treatment area clean and free of makeup (if treating the face) if possible.

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## Post-Treatment Care

- There may be redness or swelling around the treated area that can last from a few hours to a couple of days. The skin will be sensitive and feel similar to a razor burn. Treat the area gently by keeping the skin moist with Aquaphor Healing Ointment.
- Cleanse the area with a mild cleanser and avoid using soaps or abrasive material when you are 24 hours post-treatment.
- Do not pick, rub or scratch the area. Do not use any irritating substances on the treated area until the skin returns to normal.
- If the treated area will be exposed to sun, apply SPF 50 or greater after the skin returns to normal
- If your face was treated, you may resume using makeup when the skin looks and feels back to normal.
- Treated hairs will exfoliate or push out in approximately 2 to 3 weeks (sometimes sooner) and may appear darker and thicker before falling out.
- Discomfort such as swelling or redness can be relieved by an ice pack.
- Do not shave, swim or exercise strenuously for a minimum of 3 days.

Our hair is constantly changing from a number of factors that make us who we are, it's in our DNA. It is this diversity that makes proper hair removal through electrolysis a process. Each treatment can also result in lighter, finer hair as you work with us for complete and permanent results. Each individual has a different tolerance level, and that is taken into account at CHRC. Laser hair removal can be described as causing a sunburn like sensation, very few clients need this because of the comfort of our laser. Topical desensitizing creams can be applied to help ease the sensation. These are all natural reactions from the stimulus applied the skin and can be eased with the use of an ice pack and over-the-counter pain relievers. In order to prevent any additional reaction, it is critical that you inform us of any medical conditions, medications, supplements, lotions and oils.
